Moray Welsh, the violoncellist, studied with Rostropovich in Russia for two years, following a recommendation from Benjamin Britten. Moray has appeared with conductors such as Bernard Haitink, Sir Colin Davis and Andre Previn and in chamber recitals with the likes of Midori, Bashmet, Galway, Kyung Wha Chung. He will be collaborating with Jonathan Papp, recital partner to Dame Kiri te Kanawa for the last 17 years and professor at the Royal Academy of Music.
